



CERVIX SET

Product

This special suture set consists of a white polyester tape equipped at each end with blunt round bodied needles.

History

The Shirodkar technique was first described in India in 1955. The Shirodkar stitch is a purse-string stitch put into the cervix to keep it tightly closed during pregnancy.

Process

A ligature is placed around the cervix in a collar-like fashion, drawn tight, and either sutured together or tied closed. A strong tape is then woven carefully with a swage blunt needle in and out of the mucosa.

Advantages


- ☑ Will not cut or damage the wall of the cervix, when placed properly
- ✓ Prevents a miscarriage or premature birth when the cervix has been weakened
- Reduces the danger of premature labor and the associated triggering of a late abortion or a premature birth

Braided non absorbable polyester tape, 4 mm 12 pc in a box
